Argentina has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since February 10, 1967. It is not a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT).

Argentina is also part of the regional IP information platform <u>LATIPAT</u>, and a member of the "SISTEMA DE COOPERACIÓN SOBRE ASPECTOS DE INFORMACIÓN OPERACIONAL Y DE PROPIEDAD INDUSTRIAL" (<u>PROSUR</u>).

The Online Register has a Spanish interface.

Through the Online Register you can retrieve information on Legal Status and Fee Payment.

The Online Register can also be searched by **Applicant Name** and by **Priority Data**.

The Online Gazette is published weekly in Spanish. It is searchable by number and downloadable in PDF format.

Search tips

Search can be done by application number (eg. "20090100010") in the field "SOLICITUD", then click on "+" on the right to access the bibliographic data of the patent of interest.

Fee Payment information ("ANUALIDADES") is included in the patent record.

An example of data reported as a **Legal Status** is, e.g., 'Concedida - Caduca' for 'Resolucion' AR081517B1 (= "Solicitud" 20110100010); or 'Abandonada' for 'Resolucion' PA058908 (= "Solicitud" 20070100010).
